## Charge 1: Owens v. Delaney & Bittar

### *FPC rules applied*

- VII.E.2 (campaigning & surrogacy rules apply online)
- VII.F.2 (requirement to file itemized receipt, costs)

### *Verdict*

- **Considered *not* to have violated the Fair Practices Code**



## Charge 2: Chilcote v. Delaney & Bittar

### *FPC rules applied*

- II.I (monetary campaigning before 7 am prohibited)

### *Verdict*

- **Considered *not* to have violated the Fair Practices Code**



## Charge 3: Chilcote v. Delaney

### *FPC rules applied*

- VII.F.1 (spending limits, \$50.00, costs by fair market value)

### *Verdict*

- **Considered to have violated the Fair Practices Code in the Presidential position**
  - **Disqualified**
- **Considered to have violated the Fair Practices Code in the UA SAS Representative position**
  - **Disqualified**



## Charge 4: Chilcote v. Bittar

### *FPC rules applied*

- VII.F.1 (spending limits, \$50.00, costs by fair market value)

### *Verdict*

- **Considered to have violated the Fair Practices Code in the Vice-Presidential position**
  - **Disqualified**



# Biasing of UA SAS Representative Race

- With regard to the UA SAS Representative position:
  - The violations did not bias the race.
  - No repolling is necessary.
  - Results will be released with the disqualified candidate stricken.

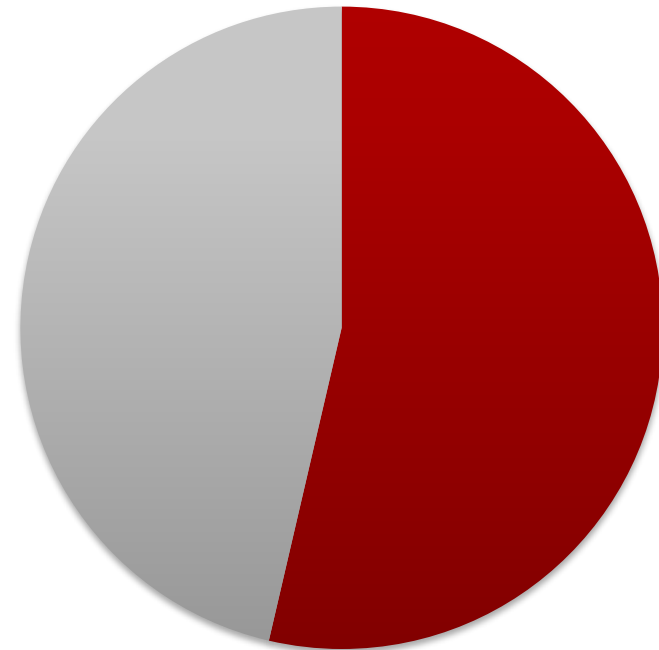
